



# Parents' Rights and Responsibilities

## Parents have the right to:

1. Expect care and safety of their children during school activities.
2. Expect confidentiality concerning problems with children's health or personal family issues.
3. Raise awareness if any irregularities in the PSW Statutes noticed.
4. Propose changes for the PSW for the good of the children and the school.
5. Be present at the lessons of their child after confirming the time with the Coordinator of the PSW and the teacher.

## Parents have the responsibility to:

1. Regularly send their children to school on Saturdays when lessons are held and check on their child's progress.
2. Help with their children's homework.
3. Send a note or call in advance if your child will be absent or tardy.
4. Pay the tuition on time.
5. Bring and pick up your children on time.
6. Make sure your child is safe until the lessons begin.
7. Send a written note in case someone other than the parent will pick up the child after school.
8. Inform the school ahead of time if the child will be absent or you decide to withdraw the child from the school.
9. Inform the school of a change in address or telephone number.
10. Inform the school of any serious illness your child may have.
11. Work with the school council and team of teachers.
12. Help organize school celebrations and fundraising.
