



Student Rules

1. The official language of the Polish school is the Polish language. Each student should speak Polish during the Polish school.
2. Students should come to school on time. Students can only be dismissed from lessons early if their parents call to give permission or if their parents submit a note indicating early dismissal is necessary. Students are responsible for the material missed.
3. **Balls, electronic games and other unnecessary accessories are not permitted in school. Cell phones must be turned off during lessons.**
4. Homework must be done independently and checked by parents.
5. In order to achieve the most success, students should read in Polish 10 – 20 minutes each day.
6. Students must follow the directions of the teachers.
7. During the break, students are not permitted to run around the school, walk through the halls or leave the school building without the knowledge of the teacher.
8. Each student is responsible for his/her place in class. If materials are broken during the lesson, parents of the child will be responsible for replacing the materials.
9. For good behavior, students may be rewarded by their teacher.
10. For bad behavior, disciplinary action may be taken with an official letter to be sent home and signed by both parents.
11. If a student continually breaks the rules of the school, that student may be dismissed from the PSW by the decision of the school council.
