



School Regulations

Rules

1. Impeccable behavior at school as well as between teachers and students is required.
2. A good attitude towards the school environment and school subjects is required.
3. Respect for others is required.
4. Active collaboration and help from children's parents is required.
5. All parents/ guardians of students enrolled in the Polish School of Wisconsin are obligated to read and acknowledge the regulations of the Polish School. This includes school regulations, parents' regulations, student regulations, teacher regulations, hall duty regulations and tuition schedule. Even If only one parent signs the form it is considered that both parents have acknowledged all regulations. Children are not allowed to attend classes until the statement is signed by the parent/guardian.

Responsibilities

1. The school has the responsibility to teach the Polish language, history, geography, as well as Polish traditions to the next generation.
2. The school has the responsibility to secure the safety and care of children during school hours.
3. The school has the responsibility to reach the goals of the curricula and utilize effective teaching methodology.
